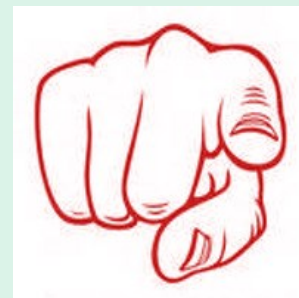

It is a good idea to have a will, enduring power of attorney and an advance health directive.

If you do not have a will, your money may not go where you desire.

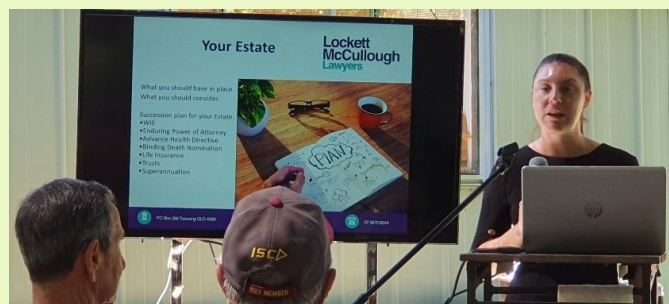
It is wise to appoint an executor who is younger than you.

Many people today do not appoint a solicitor but a family member as an executor.

Your will should be reviewed every three to five years.

Your will can be updated when there is a change in family circumstances (e.g. marriage, divorce or having children) or a change in financial circumstances.
