

Extraordinary General Weeting

This was held in the Uniting Church building on Friday 23 April at 9am. The Revocation Clause in our current rules was amended, as was suggested by the Australian Charities and Not for Profits Commission (ACNC), to enable the Shed to be registered with the Office of Fair Trading as a Deductible Gift Recipient (i.e. gifts of \$2 and over being tax exempt).

Other general business included an update about possible new sites (waiting for replies from both Help Enterprises and TAFE), how to borrow the shed trailers, the need for more supervisors, training on the CNC router and other machines and a possible reduction in the attendance fee for members who attend each day.

The Shed has two trailers which can be borrowed by members. This should be recorded in the Loan Book. He should take a photo before and after use, in case of damage. It must be attached to his car (and no-one else's) at all times. A donation of \$10 per day is appreciated.
