PRESIDENT'S INFORMATION BULLETIN TO MEMBERS

Dear Sunnybank Shed Member,

I am writing this Bulletin at a time when an extension of the South-East Queensland Lockdown has just been announced. Yet again, our usual Shed routine has been disrupted for an uncertain period of time causing frustration and inconvenience to us all. Out of all this (and previous lockdowns this 2021 year) is the fact that COVID 19 HAS NOT GONE AWAY ----- and it probably never will----- and we need to be as vigilant as ever in observing physical distancing and practising personal hygiene.

Because our Newsletter Editor is away for a few weeks on well-deserved holidays, *there will be no August newsletter*. This Information Bulletin is being issued in its place and will contain some features normally seen in our monthly newsletters.

Committee Positions for the 2021-2022 Year

There will be a call-out shortly for nominations for Members to serve on the Shed's Management Committee for the 2021-2022 year. The positions to be filled will be: President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, and five (5) Committee Members. No specific positions other than the above are being called for, in accordance with our current and previous Constitutions and By-Laws.

Members elected to serve as Committee Members will, however, be expected to *oversee* such positions as Newsletter Editor, Shed Manager, Occupational Health and Safety, Membership, Welfare, Activities, Projects etc. that will be occupied by people appointed to fulfil those roles.

It is hoped that this move to comply with the wording in the Constitution will result in a greater spread and involvement of Shedders in the management of our Shed.

Hot and Cold Water Equipment

Our Shed has received a grant so that a "zip type" hot water unit can be purchased for installing in the kitchen. This will enable hot water to be available at all times and take away the need for the use of an urn or kettles to boil water.

Cool water is now available in the kitchen area from a dispenser that has been leased on a trial basis for a year. Bottles of water will no longer be available from the fridge in the kitchen.

Financial Membership

Please do not forget to pay your membership fees for the current year. They are only \$40.00 for the year. Attendance fees are \$3.00 per session and \$5.00 on special days such as the "Last Friday BBQ". Any Member who does not pay the membership fee by 30 September will have to rejoin the Shed and pay the joining fee.

Financial membership is a requirement for election to the Management Committee and for voting at the forthcoming Annual General Meeting.

Supervisors


