FINANCIAL REPORT

It was reported by our shed treasurer Brian S, at the committee meeting in December 2022 that the shed currently has a healthy bank balance of \$29,934.00. In addition we have \$10,500 in a fixed deposit and \$22,000 grant money for the Solahart System.

- 1. Income for November amounted to \$1,484. Expenditure was \$3,029 giving a deficit of \$1,545.
- 2. A capital expenditure of \$2,000 was paid to Solahart as deposit on the solar panel installation.
- 3. Attendance fees were \$905 in November representing average weekly attendance of 100 members, inclusive of the 48 members who attended the Christmas function. Comparable average weekly attendance for the months of October and September were 77 and 88.
- 4. The Christmas lunch held at the Algester Sports Club on Friday 25th November. Receipts were \$1,495 inclusive of a donation of \$235 from Brisbane City Council. An invoice for \$2052 was paid to the Algester Sports Club giving a net expense of \$577.
- 5. Full balance sheet & P&L are available from the treasurer

UPDATE ON SOLAR ENERGY

We have an update on the Solar installation for 16th January. It is not envisaged that this install will cause any disruption of shed activities, however the installers may have some special requirements regarding parking space and power usage. Please be aware that this install is taking place and may require some patience by members.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Commencing from 1st January 2023 the shed joining fee will be \$35.00 + 6 Month Subscription will be \$20.00. All new members will continue to receive a shed shirt free of charge,

The committee has received a quote to clean the roof and gutters on the sheds prior to the solar panels being installed, it will be approximately \$150 and was completed by Wednesday 21st December.
