Well another big month comes to a close, the month of April had something for everyone. The month started with the Easter Break which led straight into Grand-kids day, quickly followed by the shed First-aid course, ANZAC Day ceremony and as always our end of month BBQ with Beyond Blue guest speaker Mike Nowland

The shed was also fortunate to receive 2 x \$500 cheques one from Sunnybank Hills Commonwealth Bank and the other from Sunnybank branch, both cheques were from the result of a community voting opportunity presented by the banks with Sunnybank Men's Shed being the most popular community service. The money will be used wisely The shed members were very excited to receive the money and with the ideas of how to spend them we needed \$5000!!

A supervisors course was also held with 3 new supervisors being trained. This will greatly help spread the load.

FIRST AID COURSE

Warwick V arranged a very successful First Aid Course to be held on Friday 14th April. This course was made possible by a grant from AMSA. We had 15 attendees which was run by Aspire

The shed tries to hold a first-aid course at least once a year so that as many people as possible are ready to help members who require first-aid

GRANT APPLICATIONS

- 1. AMSA Round \$2185.00 only \$1710.00 was spent on First Aid courses. The balance of \$485.00 we are waiting confirmation to purchase tools.
- 2. Brisbane City Council Solar Power system for the shed. The installer gave a discount leaving a surplus of \$871.00, this will be used to purchase new equipment.
- 3. \$1000.00 from Australia Post, the grant is for a new barbecue. Waiting for notification,
- 4. \$2272.75 grant from the Bendigo Bank Acacia Ridge, for purchase of AEG battery powered equipment, an English Wheel & a LPG gas powered Forge for Blacksmithing work.
- 5 2 grants of \$500.00 each from the Commonwealth Bank Sunnybank & the Sunnybank Hills.

Male suicide was the topic of this month guest speaker Mike Now land from Beyond Blue. Mike spoke to us about Beyond Blue and the work they do in the community in raising awareness of Men's Mental healty and male suicide in particular.

Mike shared his own story of depression and suicidal thoughts which hit a number of raw nerves with our members. It was obvious that men have some very difficult times in their lives, retirement, finacial loss and of course the lose of a partner.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Income for March amounted to \$1,861.

Expenditure was \$1,079. The net profit for the month was \$782.

Attendance fees for March were \$1,231. The average weekly Shed attendance was 103 members. Comparable average weekly attendance for the months of February and January were 98 and 80.
